**WHAT: Bike Fest 2010 - Our 6<sup>th</sup>. Annual event!**

**WHERE: Main Street between 5<sup>th</sup> st. to 8<sup>th</sup> st., Cottage Grove, OR 97424.**

**WHY:** To celebrate motorcycles, enthusiasts, and riders, but mostly to raise funds for Parent Partnership for Youth on Their Own of Cottage Grove. For various reasons, local teens are finding it difficult to live at home and find themselves homeless (often living in a car or “couch hopping” from one friend's house to another). However, these teens know the importance of finishing high school. In addition to the challenge of finishing high school, our area teens are in need of things like laundry detergent and laundry vouchers, soap and personal hygiene products, school supplies, etc. Last year Bike Fest raised over \$2000 for this group of teens, and over 700 bikes participated.

### **HOW CAN YOU HELP?**

- \* Cash donations directly to Parent Partnership for Youth on Their Own.

A Vendor waiver form will need to be completed and fees paid by April 25, 2010. Time for set-up is 7-9am; take-down/clean-up 4-5pm.
